Minutes of the Meeting

A meeting of Deans (Students' Affairs.) of all the N.I.Ts was held on 03.10.2008 at N.I.T. Rourkela. Deans of the following N.I.Ts were present in the meeting.

At the outset, the Director, NIT Rourkela, Prof. SK Sarangi welcomed all the members and briefed about the scope of the meeting. Prof. (Mrs) Krishna Pramanik presided over the meeting. In the above meeting the following were agreed upon unanimously and recommended for the approval and subsequent implementation by respective institutes:

1. There should be a **Core Committee for Inter-NIT Student Activities** constituted for organizing the activities of Inter-NIT competitions in Sports, Cultural and Technical activities. The constitution of the committee was proposed and agreed upon as follows:
 - a) Chairman (Director of Host NIT)
 - b) Convener (Dean (SA) of the same Institute)
 - c) Joint Convener (Dean(SA) from a neighboring Institute)
 - d) Members (Dean(SA) of remaining NITs)Note: The two institutes may on mutual agreement interchange their roles, and responsibilities.
2. The duties of **Core Committee** will be

- a) finalizing modality of conducting Inter-NIT competitions in sports, cultural and Technical activities.
 - b) finalizing the host institutes and dates of Sports, Cultural and Technical competitions.
 - c) Take feed back for improvements in future programme.
 - d) The Core Committee will be selected by rotation once in every two years. It will be decided by the members.
 - e) A web page is to be developed and maintained giving all the information and programme. The web-page should be hosted along with that for the committee of directors at NIT Jaipur, or at any other site that the directors decide. As a purely temporary measure NIT Rourkela offered to host the page till it is shifted to its permanent site.
3. For the first time the Core Committee is chosen with consensus for academic year 2008-09 and 09-10 as follows:
- Chairman : Prof. S. K. Sarangi, Director NIT Rourkela.
- Convener : Prof. (Mrs) Krishna Pramanik, Dean SA, NIT Rourkela.
- Joint Convener : Prof. D. K. Mondal, Dean SA, NIT Durgapur.
- Members : Deans SA of all other NITs.
4. It was finalized that the next meeting of the Core Committee will be held at NIT Hamirpur at the end of March or beginning of April 2009.
 5. Feedback forms from all NITs were called upon stating their willingness for organizing different sports events. The proposals were discussed in full length and it was decided that the Inter-NIT sports activities will be organized in the period of 10th – 25th Dec 2008 at different NITs *Event-wise* (Annexure-1).
 6. The committee recommends to introduce an Inter-NIT annual event on cultural activities covering events such as : classical music, classical dance, western music and dance, folk music and dance, painting and drawing, photography, *antakshari* etc. It is recommended to conduct these events preferably by two institutes jointly this year on experimental basis. NIT Rourkela volunteered to be one of the host institutes. NIT Rourkela will identify a partner institute for this academic year 2008-09. The host institute will decide and announce the dates of the programme. For the next academic year this event will be held during Sept-October period.
 7. The committee also recommends to introduce an Inter-NIT annual event on technical activities covering events such as : paper presentation, technical quiz, model and design contest, software development, debate, group discussion, elocution, essay competition, business plan competition, etc. It is recommended to

conduct these events preferably by two institutes jointly this year on experimental basis. NIT Raipur volunteered to be one of the host institutes. NIT Raipur will identify a partner institute for this academic year 2008-09. The host institute will decide and announce the dates of the programme. For the next academic year this event will be held during Sept-October period.

8. It was proposed to form a committee for entrepreneurship development in NITs.

The committee on entrepreneurship development will chalk out the programme for conducting workshops and Expert-lectures. It will coordinate all the activities of entrepreneurship development in NITs and disseminate the information and outcomes amongst all other NITs.

The committee will be formed by rotation every year. For 2008-09, the following committee is recommended:

Chairman: Prof. Sudhir Kumar Saxena (NIT Kurukshetra)

Members: 1. Prof. DK Mondal, NIT Durgapur

2. Prof. JN Yadav, NIT Jamshedpur

9. The following shall be some of the guiding principles on Inter-NIT cooperation in student activities:

- (a) All inter NIT events will be approved and monitored by the appropriate committees as given above. No institute shall host or attend a competition under 'Inter NIT' banner that is not approved by the committee.
- (b) Institutes shall be at liberty to conduct and participate in events that do not use the 'Inert NIT' phrase directly or indirectly.
- (c) One logo for all inter NIT activities should be finalized and adopted by the Core Committee. An online competition shall be conducted by the committee amongst all faculties and students of the NIT system to finalize the logo.
- (d). Attempt shall always be made to resolve the issues by consensus. However, in case of disagreement, the decision of the Chairman, Core Committee shall be binding on all.
