ADVERTISEMENT FOR ADMISSION TO MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA), SESSION 2021-23: SECOND ROUND

Applications are invited online from eligible candidates for admission to **Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme: Second Round** for the academic session 2021-23.

ELIGIBILITY

Any Graduate with 6.5 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 60% and 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 55% in case of SC/ST candidates in the qualifying degree, from the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.

- (a) Exact availability of seats (category wise) will be reflected only after the admission of candidates selected during 1st round.
- (b) If sufficient applicants are not available, seats under EWS, OBC and PH categories may be filled up by general category applicants.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Applicants satisfying minimum eligibility criteria will be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview. If the number of applicants is reasonably high, School of management may set a higher score in academic career as the minimum qualifying criteria to be called for Group Discussion & Interview. Final selection will be based on Group Discussion, Personal Interview conducted by the Institute, academic career and score of reputed national level tests for admission to Business Schools as per following weightage.

Qualifying mark for merit list: 50% of total marks irrespective of category.

NOTE: The candidates appearing in the final semester/year examination may also apply for the above course. However, they have to produce their mark/grade sheet showing 6.5 CGPA or 60% for general category candidates and 6.0 CGPA or 55% in case of SC/ST candidates (as the case may be) in aggregate latest by 30th September 2021 failing which their admission will stand cancelled. Such students, in order to be eligible for admission, must produce a certificate in the prescribed format [Annexure I], signed by the Principal or Registrar of the College last attended stating that all examinations including practical necessary for award of the degree have been completed. OBC & PH category students are advised to submit the respective Annexures available in the application portal.

Applicants are required to send hard copy of the signed application form along with the payment acknowledgement to the HOD, School of Management, National Institute of Technology, Rourkela, Odisha, Pin: 769008, in a closed envelope superscribed with "Application for MBA admission 2021-23 (Second round)". However, the candidates called for interview are required to submit signed copy of the application form and a set of photocopies of all certificates to the HOD at the time of interview. They also need to produce original certificates from HSC onwards for verification to the Academic Office at the time of admission.

NOTES:

A student admitted to the said programme shall be required to pay at the time of joining and also in subsequent semesters, the prevalent tuition fee and other fees as prescribed by the Institute till he/she is on roll including the period beyond the normal duration. There is no discount in fees for reduced academic load. Normally the fee structure will not change during the programme; but if the Institute revises the fee structure in the middle of a programme, a student is obliged to comply. The fee structure is given in the above table. Tuition fee and all other fees except the one time fees will be collected in two equal installments during semester registration.



If a student is removed or she/he withdraws/leaves the Institute in the mid-session without completing the entire programme, all fees paid including the caution deposit will be forfeited by the institute. Mess advance may be refunded after deduction of dues, if any.

Information/Guidelines

- 1. Disability certificate shall be issued by Medical Board of at least three doctors duly constituted by the State or Central government under PWD Act.(One of the members of the Board should be the specialist in the particular field for assessing Locomotor, Visual disability, Hearing and Speech disability, Mental disorder and Leprosycured)
- 2. If disability is likely to decrease (temporary type) then, the certificate should be valid up to September 15, 2021.
- 3. For candidature under physically challenged category, candidates only with a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to various programmes without any special concessions and exemptions.
- 4. The Medical Officer of NIT Rourkela may assess the Physically Challenged (PH) certificate and the decision of the Medical Officer is final and binding on the candidate.
