# \* Authentication of Citizenship Card for applicants from Nepal.

- (i) Applicants applying under DASA Scheme 2024 from Nepal should submit (online) a copy of the authenticated residence proof (Passport or Citizenship Card) along with the online application form, to be eligible for considering their application.
- (ii) Applicants can contact Embassy of India in Kathmandu, Nepal or Embassy of Nepal at New Delhi for verification and authentication of the residential proof certificates.
- (iii) Applicants should submit authenticated residential proof documents at the time of admission failing which the provisional admission granted would be cancelled.
- (iv) Hence applicants from Nepal applying under DASA Scheme 2024 are strongly advised to start the authentication process immediately by contacting the office of Embassy of Nepal at New Delhi or Embassy of India in Kathmandu, Nepal at the earliest, so that they will be able to submit the authenticated residential proof certificates at the time of admission.

(During physical reporting in the Institute, the originals will be verified with the photocopy submitted during physical reporting and if any document is not found to be in order, the admission may be cancelled).




