ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE SESSION 2020-22 FOR ADMISSION TO MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

Applications are invited online from eligible candidates for admission to **Master of Business** Administration (MBA) for the academic session 2020-22.

ELIGIBILITY

The minimum eligibility criterion is B. Tech. or B.E. or B. Arch. (with mathematics as one of the subjects in Class XII), or four year degree programme leading to B. Sc. Engineering (with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the UG programme), or four year degree programme leading to Bachelor of Science degree (with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the UG programme), or Master of Science (with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the UG programme), or Master of Arts in Economics (with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the UG programme), or Master of Arts in Economics (with Mathematics as one of the subjects in the UG programme) with aggregate of 65% or a CPI of 6.5 on a scale of 10 from any AICTE recognised institute/university, IITs, NITs, and IIITs.

ADMISSION TEST

The Institute uses the CAT scores for short-listing/selecting the candidate for Post-Graduate Programme(s) in MBA, IIMs have no role either in the selection process or in the conduct of the programme.

If sufficient applicants are not available, seats under EWS, OBC and PH categories may be filled up by general category applicants.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The applicant has to appear for Common Admission Test (CAT) and simultaneously has to apply for School of Management, NIT Rourkela. Depending upon the CAT Score. Career credentials and other achievement, the candidate will be called for GD/PI at multiple locations in India. In the second step the School will select candidates out of prospective pools on the basis of CAT Score, GD /PI performance, Work experience and career marks. The following method will be used to calculate the final score.

NOTE: The candidates appearing B. Tech (final semester) examination may also apply for the above course. However, they have to produce their mark/grade sheet showing 60% marks or CGPA 6.5 (as the case may be) in aggregate <u>latest by 30th September 2020 failing which their admission will stand</u> <u>cancelled</u>. Such students, at the time of admission, must produce a certificate signed by the Principal or Registrar of the College last attended stating that all examinations including practical necessary for award of the degree have been completed in order to be eligible for admission in the prescribed format [Annexure I], to be uploaded along with the selection list. OBC & PH category students are advised to submit the respective Annexures available in the application portal.

HOW TO APPLY

Interested candidates satisfying the eligibility criteria may submit online application at <u>http://eapplication.nitrkl.ac.in</u> following the instructions:

Applicants are advised to (a) read the advertisement carefully, (b) prepare a Demand Draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of "Director NIT Rourkela" payable at Rourkela, towards payment of application fee and (c) fill up and submit the online application form accordingly.

Applicants are required to send hard copy of the signed application form along with the Demand Draft to the Registrar, National Institute of Technology, Rourkela, Odisha, Pin - 769008. However, candidates who will be called for interview are required to submit signed copy of the application form and a set of Xerox copies of all certificates to the HOD on reporting day of the interview. They also need to produce original certificates from HSC onwards for verification to the Academic Office at the time of admission.

A student admitted to the said programme shall be required to pay at the time of joining and also in subsequent semesters, the prevalent tuition fee and other fees as prescribed by the Institute till he/she is on roll including the period beyond the normal duration. There is no discount in fees for reduced academic load. Normally the fee structure will not change during the programme; but if the Institute revises the fee structure in the middle of a programme, a student is obliged to comply. The fee structure is given in the above table. Tuition fee and all other fees except the one time fees will be collected in two equal instalments during semester registration.

REFUND

Information/Guidelines

- Disability certificate shall be issued by Medical Board of at least three doctors duly constituted by the State or Central government under PWD Act. (One of the members of the Board should be the specialist in the particular field for assessing Locomotor, Visual disability, Hearing and Speech disability, Mental disorder and Leprosy cured)
- 2. If disability is likely to decrease (temporary type) then, the certificate should be valid up to September 15, 2020.
- 3. For candidature under physically challenged category, candidates only with a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to various programmes without any special concessions and exemptions.
- 4. The Medical Officer of NIT Rourkela may assess the Physically Challenged (PH) certificate and the decision of the Medical Officer is final and binding on the candidate.
