ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The National Conference on “*GST 2.0 Reforms: Vision for Viksit Bharat @ 2047*” seeks to provide a comprehensive platform for examining the transformative role of Goods and Services Tax (GST) in shaping India’s evolving economic landscape. As India advances towards the vision of *Viksit Bharat*, the conference focuses on how GST reforms can shape MSME competitiveness, digitalisation, and contribute to broad-based economic transformation. In this context, the conference will also analyse how GST facilitates or constrains innovation in MSMEs and startups, and suggest policy measures to promote innovativeness and sustainability of startups. The conference will explore sectoral dimensions of GST across manufacturing, energy, services, healthcare, and e-commerce, while also highlighting regional disparities and fiscal dynamics. Special attention will be given to the interplay between Central GST (CGST) and State GST (SGST), examining variations in tax structures and revenue flows across states. In addition, the conference will address the complexities of integrating the informal economy within the GST framework, identifying both challenges and emerging opportunities. By fostering interdisciplinary dialogue among academics, policymakers, and practitioners, the conference aims to generate evidence-based insights and actionable policy recommendations to strengthen the GST regime and support India’s long-term development trajectory towards *Viksit Bharat @ 2047*.

CALL FOR PAPERS

Original, unpublished abstracts and full papers are invited for presentation at the conference. Submissions should align with the broad themes of the conference; however, contributions addressing allied and interdisciplinary areas relevant to GST reforms and economic policy are also encouraged. Indicative broad thematic areas are as follows:

Theme 1: GST structure, competitiveness and economic transformation

Theme 2: GST reforms and sectoral impacts

Theme 3: GST, innovation and the startup ecosystem

Theme 4: GST and regional implications

Theme 5: GST and the informal economy

Theme 6: GST compliance, digitalisation and Ease of Doing Business in MSMEs

Submission and Timelines

Faculty members, early-career researchers and registered Ph.D. scholars from universities and research institutions, as well as policymakers and industry practitioners are eligible to apply.

Authors are required to submit an abstract of 250-300 words via email to gst.conference2026@gmail.com no later than **30th April 2026**. The abstract should clearly state the title of the paper, and outline the research objectives, methodology, and/or preliminary findings. Authors must indicate the name of the presenter and his/her contact details (affiliation and email). All submissions will be peer-reviewed, and the decisions on acceptance of abstracts will be communicated by **15th May 2026**.

Authors of accepted abstracts will be required to submit a full paper no later than **30th June 2026**. The full paper should typically be between 6000-8000 words inclusive of references, tables, and figures. Manuscripts must be prepared in MS Word format and should follow a consistent academic citation style. Submission of the full paper is mandatory for presentation at the conference. All full papers will be reviewed for academic quality and relevance, and notification regarding their acceptance will be communicated. Authors who fail to submit the full paper by the deadline will not be included in the conference programme.

Registration

A registration fee of INR 1000 is applicable for participation in the conference and is payable only by authors of accepted papers. Authors must pay the registration fee before **15th July** for their paper to be included in the conference programme. Details regarding registration and payment will be shared in due course.

Travel and accommodation details

No TA/DA will be provided to the participants by the organisers. Limited accommodation will be provided to all outstation participants in the NITR Guest Houses on twin-sharing basis during the conference, subject to availability and prior request. Local hospitality including conference meals will be arranged during the conference days.

Certificate

Certificates of completion will be given to the registered participants after successful completion of the conference.

Publication

As per ICSSR guidelines, the conference proceedings and related outputs will be published by ICSSR. Selected papers will be considered accordingly.

Venue

The conference will be conducted in *offline* mode at the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, NIT Rourkela.

How to reach NIT Rourkela

En route Howrah-Mumbai main line of South Eastern Railway, Rourkela city is well connected to all major cities of India by railway network and inter- and intra-state bus services. It takes around 2 hours from Jharsuguda airport, 6 hours from Kolkata airport and around 3 hours from Ranchi airport by train. Rourkela railway station is approximately 6 kms from NIT Campus.
