A. GENERAL AND PROCEDURAL MATTERS

BOG – 14(2007) – 1: Welcome to all members and invitees to the meeting by the Chairman.

Chairman welcomed the members and the invitee to the 14th meeting of the Board of Governors. Leave of absence was granted to all members absent.

BOG – 14(2007) – 2: Confirmation of the minutes of the 13th Meeting of the BOG.

The minutes of the 13th Meeting were sent to the members vide letter No. NITR/DR/BOG/2007/I/66 Date: June 24, 2007 inviting comments on the correctness of the recording. No comments or suggestions have been received. The Board was requested to confirm the minutes.

The Board confirmed the Minutes of the 13th Meeting of BOG.

BOG – 14(2007) – 3: To report on the actions taken on the decisions made in the 13th Meeting of BOG held on 28th May, 2007 and to discuss matters arising out of the minutes.

A summary of actions taken against the decisions of the BOG in its 13th Meeting held on 28th May 2007 was presented for the Board's consideration.

The Board noted the actions taken and approved the report with the following remarks:

1. BOG-13(2007)-7: Recruitment for the post of Administrative Officers.

The Board discussed in detail the advertisement No.14/2007 dated 21.06.2007 (Annexure-A1). for the post of Finance Officer and Assistant Registrars, which was published in newspapers and Institute website. The text of the advertisement including qualification and experience requirement was approved by the Board. Director reported that a number of applications have been received for all the above posts.

The Board, however, felt that under certain circumstances the requirement of "First class Masters Degree" should be replaced with "Master degree with a superior academic record". Depending on the number of applications received, short-listing criteria can be fixed to invite the required number of candidates to interview. Considering the good number of application received against the present advertisement, the Board decided to go ahead with the selection process this time.

The Board approved the following panel of experts for conducting the interview in addition to Director, Registrar and Member from the MHRD:

- 1) Dr. Saroj K. Mohapatra (Former professor at XIMB, presently GM (HR), POSCO.
- 2) Shri Nandkumar, Executive Director (Finance) RSP. Rourkela.
- 3) Dr. D. Gunasekharan, Registrar, IIT., Kharagpur.
- 4) Shri A.K. Das, General Manager (Finance) NALCO, Bhubaneswar.

In addition, the Board approved the name of Shri L. Kindo, IAS (Retd.) former member Board of Revenue, Government of Orissa as SC/ST minority member in all selection committees.

2. BOG-13 (2007)-10: To consider and approve the write off of obsolete and unserviceable stock items.

The Director presented a detailed list of obsolete and unserviceable stock items to be written off for approval by the Board. The Board approved the same. The list of items is appended in Appendix A1 in electronic form (CD).

Attention of the Board was drawn to item BWC: 7(2007) - 4 (status of new major projects) on Page. No. 32 of Annexure.

For the largest ever construction project (SI.No.1 & 2), 11 nationally reputed firms have been short-listed. i.e. (1) Engineering Projects (I) Ltd. (2) Uttar Pradesh Rajakiya Nigam Ltd. (3) Larsen & Toubro Ltd. (4) Nagarjuna Construction Company Limited (5) Shapoorji Pallonji & Co Limited (6) Ahluwalia Contracts (I) Ltd. (7) Gammon India Ltd. (8) Consolidated Construction Consortium Ltd. (9) IVRCL Infrastructure &

Projects Ltd., (10) Unity Infrastructure Projects Ltd. & (11) Simplex Infrastructure Limited. The tender documents were presented before the Board. The total cost of approximately Rs.80.00 crores was approved to be met from plan grant over a three-year period (along with other items totaling approximately Rs.10.00 crores per year). B. POLICY AND IMPORTANT ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

BOG- 14(2007) - 7: To assign names in stead of numbers to hostels, auditoriums and Library - recommendation of the Committee of Deans and Heads of Departments

The item was deferred.

BOG – 14(2007) – 8: To Consider the recognition of Non-teaching employees' Service Association in light of the letter No.F.20-12/2004-TS-III dt. June 22, 2004.

The Board analysed the situation in detail and resolved that there will be only one Non-Teaching Employees Service Association representing all regular employees of the Institute except faculty and officers, in stead of the two associations (NTESA and Class-IV Employees Service Association) existing today. All employees at their free will, will be entitled to membership of the Association. No member can be debarred from joining or leaving the association. No parallel association will be recognized by the Board.

Director and Registrar were advised to inform all staff members of the Boards' decision and advise them to form a single service association, frame a new constitution, its bye laws and present it to the Institute for approval. The constitution of the new association should address to the concerns of segments of the non-teaching employees – the Group B &C, as well as Group D employees who had, hitherto, formed two associations.

It was further clarified that:

- (a) The association and all its members must abide by the conduct rules of the Institute, which, at the moment, are based on those of IIT, Delhi and Government of India.
- (b) The association nor any of its office bearers shall join any federation of associations or any other entity not recognized by the Institute or the Government of India.
- (c) The recognition will be withdrawn if the association fails to honour its commitment to the Institute, to conduct free and fair election of office bearers or violates conduct rules or violates any decision/directive of the BOG.

The Director was authorized by the Board to examine the revised constitution in light of the directive of the Board, and to accord recognition on behalf of the Board if satisfied.

The Board's attention was drawn to the recent activities of the NTESA office bearers, which are clearly in violation of conduct rules. In particular, the Board was informed about:

- (a) Sending letters to Chairman, BOG, the Ministry and Directors of other NITs without following the "proper channel" against the decision of the Board,
- (b) Calling upon the members to pursue " agitation" against decisions of the Board and
- (c) The Secretary of the NTESA serving as the Vice President of the "<u>All</u><u>India NIT Non-Teaching Employees Federation</u>, which is not recognized by the Government of India and sending letters to higher authorities in that capacity.

The Board took a lenient view and decided to ignore violations of conduct rules in the instant case in the greater interest of achieving a peaceful environment on the campus.

It was, however, resolved that further violation of conduct rules will be taken seriously to protect the long term interest of the Institute. All employees, including elected officials of associations are personally responsible for their own conduct and will be subject to relevant regulations.

The recognition will be initially for a period of 2 years, and will be renewed every two years subject to fulfilling conditions of renewal attached in Annexure A6.

The Director and Registrar were directed to take appropriate measures as stated in Central Government conduct rules and disciplinary procedures against erring employees to ensure respect for law on campus.

BOG – 14(2007) – 9: To report on the revision of MoA after acceptance by the Ministry

The Board in its 12th meeting held on 09.02.2007, vide resolution No. BOG-12 (2007)-8 modified the list of departments and centers and sought the concurrence of the Ministry. The acceptance of the Ministry has been obtained, which is given in Annexure. While some departments & centers have been created, the Departments of Life Science, Industrial Design, School of Management and Tribal Development Centre will be created as soon as infrastructure is available.

The Board noted the approval by MHRD. for revision of Memorandum of Association.

BOG – 14(2007) –12: Rotation of Headship: Request of Prof. S. Panigrahi for amendment of rules.

Prof. S. Panigrahi, Professor in the Department of Physics requested certain amendments to the rules in selection of HOD in small departments. He suggests that in departments with one professor, there should be no rotation of headship. The administration did not recommend this approach because it leads to perpetuity of authority and kills dynamism.

The representation of Prof. Panigrahi, and his suggestions thereto were placed before the Board for its consideration.

The Board considered the issue in detail and resolved that rotation of Headship as per the decision of the Board vide resolution No.BOG-9 (2005)-7 dt.7.2.2006 should continue.

As per rule, request for resignation /Voluntary retirement made by the faculty members and officers of Govt. establishments require acceptance by the appointing authority. All the faculty members and officers mentioned above fulfill the requirements for acceptance of resignation /voluntary retirement. Chairman, BOG has accepted their requests on recommendation of Director and the concerned faculty members have been relieved.

This is for information and confirmation of the Board.

The Board approved the resignation / V.R. of the above faculty members and officers.

BOG – 14(2007) –14: Representation of NIT Employees to Chairman, BOG

The following representations by NIT employees received directly by the Chairman, BOG were placed before the Board in the 13th meeting and referred to the Director for detailed study. Because the documents were voluminous they could not be discussed in the 13th meeting.

(a) Representation of Sri H. Barkey

Sri Harihar Barkey has made a representation to the National Commission for SC/ST with a copy to the Chairman, BOG against alleged violation of reservation roster. His letter was forwarded to the Institute by the Chairman vide his letter dated May 29, 2007 also be the SC/ST Commission vide this letter No.H-3/HRD-16/2007-SSW-III dated 31.05.2007. Registrar's pointby-point reply to the SC/ST Commission vide his letter No. NITR/Estt/1014 dated 26.07.2007 is enclosed for information of the BOG.

Mr. Barkey, who is associated with the Lok Janshakti Party, has also appealed to the political party to intervene. Mr. A. K. Sengupta, National Vice President of Janshakti Mazdoor Sabha met the director on 30th July 2007 and appeal to do something for Mr. Barkey. A representative of Bahujan Samaj Party also met the Director in favour of Mr. Barkey.

Mr. Barkey appeared for the post of Assistant Superintendent against external advertisement under SC reserved category and was not successful. He feels that the Institute has done him an injustice by putting him against " highly qualified " external (an internal) younger candidates. In spite of our good wishes to all our employees, we had no means, nor any reason, for rejecting more competent and brighter candidates of the SC community to favour Mr. Barkey. This has been communicated to the SC/ST Commission by the Registrar. It may also be noted that, with approval of the Chairman, BOG, the selection committee co-opted an eminent SC/ST official, Mr. L. Kundu, IAS (Retd.), former member, Board of Revenue, Government of Orissa in the Committee. The Committee's recommendation was unanimous.

The Board reviewed the original representation of Mr. Barkey and the reply sent by the Institute to the SC/ST commission. The reply was approved, post facto, and the administration was authorized to proceed with the process of interaction with the commission as per normal rules of the Institute.

(b) Representation of Shri R. C. Mallick, General Secretary, NTESA and Vice President of "All India NIT Non-Teaching Employees Federation.

The All India NIT Non-Teaching Employees Federation is not recognized either by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India or by the Institute. Representation in the name of such federation ordinarily violates the Conduct Rules of the Institute. Any representation to higher authorities should be routed through proper channel. Thus letter has been addressed directly to the Chairman, BOG without proper channel.

The Board may also take into cognizance the letter No.F.20-12/2004.TS.III dated 11th May 2004 from Dr. G. L. Jambhulkar, Deputy Educational Advisor, Ministry of HRD, which states that:

"....the above federation is not a recognized organization and thus does not have any legal entity. Therefore should not take into account the instructions/letters issued by the above federation... those who involve in the activities of the above federation, serious action will be taken against them under NIT rules".

Coming to the contents of the letter of the federation forwarded by Sri Mallick to our Chairman, the federation has requested the Hon'ble Minister of HRD to reject all recommendations of the NIT Director's committee on rationalisation of staff structure and pay scales of non-teaching employees, maintain status quo in present pay scales, and adopt a different pay structure suggested by them.

The Board may discuss the issue and take appropriate decision.

The Board noted that the letter was addressed to MHRD and did not take a stand on the issues.

It noted that Mr. Mallick has violated conduct rules by writing such letters without approval of the Institute. The Board, however, took a lenient view on Mr. Mallick and decided to condone the lapse in the instant case.

The Director was advised to direct Mr. Malice to refrain from such activities in future and to inform him that such activities will be taken very seriously in future.

BOG – 14(2007) – 15: Abolition of the Planning & Design Cell

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The Planning & Design Cell was created in the Department of Civil Engineering vide REEK BOG resolution to take over the construction work on campus. Faculty and staff members were engaged in all architectural and structural design work as well as in supervision of projects against a fee. While the Cell rendered valuable service, it has lost its utility in view of the substantially increased activity and need for professional quality well above what we have been able to provide. The cell has been defunct for the past three years.

The Board is requested to consider formal abolition of the Cell and closure of all outstanding accounts.

The Board approved the proposal for abolition of the Planning & Design Cell.

BOG – 14(2007) – 16: Excess payment against LTC bill of Groups A & B officers

As per LTC regulations of the Government of India, only officers drawing basic pay above Rs.18, 400/- can avail LTC air. An exception to this rule was made in 2005 permitting all Groups A & B officers by air travel for visiting Andaman Nicobar Islands. This provision was valid for only 6 months and has now been withdrawn.

The Swamy's Handbook on Government regulations, which is widely referred to in all Government offices including NIT Rourkela, has done a mistake. It states both in 2006 and some 2007 editions that the facility is still available to Group A & B officers. 17 faculty members drawing basic pay less than Rs.18,400/- proposed air travel to Port Blair and their requests were approved because administration was misguided by Swamy's Handbook. While the practice has now been stopped, a decision must be taken regarding recovery of excess payment totalling a sum of Rs.6, 87,067/-. The faculty members have appealed to the Board of Governors for exemption from recovery of the dues.

Board is requested to consider their request.

The Board noted in principle that what can be recovered can not be written off. Director was advised to recover the excess payment made against LTC Bills from the pay bills of the concerned officers and faculty members. The Director was permitted to waive the interest and to fix the period of recovery.

i) Case of Mr. S.S. Senapati relating to investment of CPF fund in various banks follow up of Board resolution No.BOG-12(2007)-22.

Mr. S.S. Senapati retired as a Senior Assistant on 30.09.2005. During his tenure as Senior Assistant, he dealt with investment of P.F. funds. Records show that, in violation of rules, agency commission was paid on some of the investments in UTI bank. On further enquiry it was found that commission has been paid to one Ms

Parbati Senapati. Mr. S.S.Senapati says that he does not know any person name Parbati Senapati, while official records show that he has a sister with that name. The Institute proposed him to surrender the agency commission paid to his sister along with a small penalty; but he has not accepted the proposal instead, his advocate has threatened legal action against the Institute.

The Board was requested to consider the case and give appropriate direction to the administration.

The Board vide resolution No.BOG-12(2007)-22 dated 09.2.2007 directed to withhold the payment of gratuity and other retirement dues of Mr. S.S.Senapati and refer the case to an advocate in the Institutes panel.

On advice of the Board, the case of Mr. S.S. Senapati was referred to the Institute advocate for his legal opinion. As per the opinion of advocate Mr. S.S. Senapati has committed grave financial misconduct. Therefore, before recovery of agent commission, the disciplinary proceeding should be initiated against Sri S.S. Senapati forthwith and after following the due procedure of law, the final order be passed. After communicating the said final order to Mr. S.S. Senapati, the recovery can only be made. Put up to the Board for advice and necessary action.

The Board advised to proceed as per the advice of the Advocate.

A. Major Events

- A Short Term Course on "Evolutionary Computing Techniques with Engineering Applications" was conducted from 11.06.2007 to 16.06.2007 under the Coordinatorship of Prof. G. Panda, Professor & Head, Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering.
- A Short Term Course on "Advanced Topics in DSP with applications to communication & Instrumentation "was conducted from 18.06.2007 to 23.06.2007 under the Coordinator-ship of Prof. G. Panda, Professor & Head, Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering.
- A Short Term Course on "Recent Trends in Object Oriented Software Development" was conducted from 25.06.2007 to 29.06.2007 under the Coordinatorship of Prof. S. K. Rath, Professor, Department of Computer Science & Engineering,
- A Short Term Course on "Advanced Control System Techniques and Their Applications" was conducted from 25.06.2007 to 06.07.2007 under the Coordinatorship of Prof. B. D. Subudhi, Assistant Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering.

B. New R & D projects received

E. TEQIP Programme:

TEQIP programme, which was originally sanctioned for a sum of Rs. 10.00 crore, has been augmented to Rs.17,00 crore and performance audit has been carried out accordingly.

The BOG Meeting vide resolution No.BOG-12(2007)-25/2 dt. 09.02.2007 had approved reimbursement of expenses towards purchase of books up to Rs.1000/- per annum for the faculty members. It is proposed that this figure is increased to Rs.4000/- per annum as that of IITs and several NITs. For costly books, a faculty member may claim the difference in the next financial year. Expenses cannot be carried forward beyond one year. Professional membership fee may be given 75% of the actual membership fee, subject to a limit of Rs. 5000/-. The difference if any may be claimed from contingency grant of sponsored research projects, where the faculty member is an investigator.

Finance Committee may approve.

Finance Committee approved the reimbursement of Book allowance of Rs.3000/-per annum and professional membership fee of 100% of one professional body (national or international) subject to a limit of Rs.5000/- per annum to all faculty members.

F.C-10 (2007)-6:

To provide mobile and land phone facilities to Faculty, Administrative staffs and Secretary to Director and Registrar.

In order to motivate and retain the faculty members it is felt that the facilities should be extended as that of IITs and other comparable Institutions. All the faculty members and officers are given telephone allowance of Rs. 750/- per month. The Committee considered the question of performance evaluation of contractors, particularly those who have completed their projects for future assignment of contracts. It was decided to indentify the earlier construction projects where poor work has been done, or where disproportionate amount of supervision had to be spent to ensure quality at every step, and to put the Contractors in a "Forbidden List of Contractors or Vendors. Then contractors will be ineligible for bidding for linstitute contracts (works and procurement) for a period of 5 years.

In addition, the Institute shall maintain a list of "restricted List of contractors and vendors". A vender or contractor will be added to this list if he tries to sell a substandard product, delays delivery beyond reasonable periods, charges clearly unreasonable price, or otherwise acts in bad faith. Names of such firms will be made available to the faculty and officers of the Institute, so that they can take precautionary steps while sending limited tender enquiries.

Listing of firms in any of the 2 lists will be done only on recommendation of a committee headed by a Dean and approved by Director. The list will be reported to BOG from time to time.

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[Recognition of Non-Teaching Employees Service Association of NIT Rourkela]

Conditions for recognition

The Service Association which fulfils the following conditions may be recognized by the authority, namely: -

- a) An application for recognition of Service Association has been made to the authority containing Memorandum of Association, Constitutions, Bye-laws of the Association, Names of office-bearers, total membership and any other information as may be required by the authority;
- b) the Service Association has been formed primarily with the object of promoting the common service interest of its members;
- c) membership of the Service Association has been restricted to a distinct category of employees having common interest, all such employees being eligible for membership of the Service Association;
- d) (i) The Association represents minimum 35 per cent of total number of category of employees provided that where there is only one Association which commands more than 35 per cent membership, another Association with second highest membership, although less than 35 per cent may be recognized if it commands at least 15 per cent membership;

(ii) The membership of the employees shall be automatically discontinued on his ceasing to belong to such category;

- e) employees who are in service shall be members or office bearers of the Service Association;
- f) the Service Association shall not be formed to represent the interests, or on the basis, of any caste, tribe or religious denomination or of any group within or section of such caste, tribe or religious denomination;
- g) the Executive of the Service Association has been appointed from amongst the members only; and
- h) the funds of the Service Association consist exclusively of subscriptions from members and grants, if any, made by the Government and are applied only for the furtherance of the objects of the Service Association.

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Conditions for renewal

The Service Association recognized under these Rules shall comply with the following conditions, namely : -

- the Service Association shall not send any representation or deputation except in connection with a matter which is of common interest to members of the Service Association;
- j) the Service Association shall not espouse or support the cause of individual employees relating to service matters;
- k) the Service Association shall not maintain any political fund or lend itself to the propagation of the views of any political party or a member of such party;
- 1) all representations by the Service Association shall be submitted through proper channel and shall be addressed to the Director;
- m) a list of members and office bearers and up-to-date copy of the rules and an audited statement of accounts of the Service Association shall be furnished to the Director annually through proper channel after the General Annual Meeting so as to reach the Director before the 1st day of July each tear;
- n) the Service Association shall abide by and comply with all the provisions of its Constitution/Bye-laws;
- o) any amendment in the Constitution/Bye-laws of the Service Association, after its recognition under these Rules, shall be made only with the prior approval of the authority;
- p) the Service Association shall not start or publish any periodical magazine or bulletin without the previous approval of the authority;
- q) the Service Association shall cease to publish any periodical, magazine or bulletin, if directed by the authority to do so, on the ground that the publication thereof is prejudicial to the interests of the Institute or authority;
- r) the Service Association shall not address any communication to, or enter into correspondence with, a foreign authority except through the authority which shall have the right to withhold it;
- s) the Service Association shall not do any act or assist in the doing of any act which, if done by a employee, would contravene any of the provisions of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964;
- communications addressed by the Service Association or by any office-bearer on its behalf to the authority shall not contain nay disrespectful or improper language.

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Amendments to be incorporated in the Constitution of Non Teaching Employees Service Association, NIT Rourkela

Article-2:

d) "Employer" means Board of Governors, National Institute of Technology, Rourkela.

f) "Authority" means Board of Governors, National Institute of Technology, Rourkela or such other authorities as may be declared by the Statutes to be the authorities of the Institute.

Article-14:

- a) The Association will strive to put forth its view points in writing through proper channel before the authority. If the issues are not settled through correspondence it will seek a meeting with the administration. However, on some emergency issues the Association will seek meeting with prior verbal permission.
 - b) The Association shall negotiate with the administration for better benefits for its members.
 - d) The association will always deal with the Management in accordance with the Government and Institute rules. All representation sent to higher authorities shall be routed through proper channel.
 - e) Every member of the Association shall be free to air his grievances before the authorities.
 - h) The Executive Committee shall submit the following documents to authority before 31st January every year.
 - a. Valid membership
 - b. funds position
 - c. Audited statement of Account

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Article-17:

- a) Before 30 days expiring of last term, the General Secretary with a resolution will seek permission from the authority of the Institute for conducting fresh election.
- b) The authority will fix a tentative date.
- c) The authority will fix the date in consultation the Association and nominate the Election Officer.
- d) Election Officer will notify the date so finalized by the authority for election and intimate the same to the authority. The last date of nomination should be clearly specified. No nomination will be received after the last date.
- j) Any dispute arising out of the election will be decided by the authority.

BOG–14(2007)–19: Any other item with permission of Chair.

Case of Mr. S.S. Senapati relating to investment of CPF fund in various banks follow up of Board resolution No. BOG-12(2007)-22.

Mr. S.S. Senapati retired as a Senior Assistant on 30.09.2005. During his tenure as Senior Assistant, he dealt with investment of P.F. funds. Records show that, in violation of rules, agency commission was paid on some of the investments in UTI bank. On further enquiry it was found that commission has been paid to one Ms. Parbati Senapati. Mr. S.S. Senapati says that he does not know any person name Parbati Senapati, while official records show that he has a sister with that name. The Insitute proposed him to surrender the agency commission paid to his sister along with a small penalty; but he has not accepted the proposal. Instead, his advocate has threatened legal action against the Insitute.

The Board was requested to consider the case and give appropriate direction to the administration.

The Board vide resolution No. BOG-12(2007)-22 dated 9.02.2007 directed to withhold the payment of gratuity and other retirement dues of Mr. S.S. Senapati and refer the case to an advocate in the Institute's panel.

On advice of the Board, the case of Mr. S. S. Senapati was referred to the Institute advocate for his legal opinion. As per the opinion of advocate, Mr. S.S. Senapati has committed grave financial misconduct. Therefore, before recovery of agent commission, the disciplinary proceeding should be initiated against Sri S.S. Senapati forthwith and after following the due procedure of law, the final order be passed. After communicating the said final order to Mr. S.S. Senapati, the recovery can only be made.

Put up to the Board for advice and necessary action.

Sir,

I have perused your letter under reference alongwith the proceeding of the committee held on 30.03.2007 in respect of irregularities in the P.F. fund investment by Mr. S.S. Senapati, exemployee of your institute.

The following is my legal opinion.

1. Mr. S.S. Senapati was one of the employee of your institute retired from service on superannuation in September, 2005. During tenure Mr. Senapati as a Senior Assistant of your institute, was dealing with the investment of P.F. Funds. The records reveal that the agency commission on some of the investments in UTI Bank was paid to one Mrs. Parbati Senapati, the sister of Mr. Senapati which is disputed by Mr. S.S. Senapati. According to Mr. Senapati he does not know any person named Mrs. Parbati Senapati, although official records show that she is his sister. It was reported by the Chartered Accountant in it's audit report that the agent commission from 01.04.2002 to 31.03.2004 was received by Mrs. Parbati

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Senapati, although usually the agent's commission should have been deposited in the account of Board of Trustee of the Institute. The above financial irregularities of non-deposit is amount to an illegal act and grave misconduct. Although Mr. S.S. Senapati was asked to deposit the said agent commission in the account of Board of Trustees of the Institute, but he failed to do so. The meeting of the Board decided to deduct the aforesaid amount of agent's Commission from the gratuity of Mr. S.S. Senapati, since Mr. Senapati has already retired from service. Subsequently, a meeting was held on 30.03.2007 under the Chairmanship of Prof. K.C. Patra, Civil Engineering Department, wherein Prof. S. Rauta of Electrical Engineering Department and Sri S.N. Dash, Assistant Registrar (F & A) were members. In the said meeting the reply of Mr. S.S. Senapati regarding the above noted financial irregularities was placed, but the same was satisfactory as there was no specific reply by him to the issue. Therefore, the decision which had already taken in the 8th meeting of BOT held on 26.12.2005 recommending for recovery of the said agents commission was also considered and unanimously accepted keeping in view that no employee should generate personal benefits out of the Institute's fund. Thereafter the matter was placed before the Director and the Director directed for deduction of Rs. 75,000/

- from the gratuity of Mr. Senapati with intimation to hi. In the meanwhile Sri Senapati had issued an Advocate's notice for release of gratuity amount and other retirement benefit within fifteen days otherwise he will proceed to Court of law.

According to me, all retirement dues shall be paid immediately to him except the amount of Rs. 75,000/- towards deduction of the agents commission including the interest, since Sri Senapati has already retired from service on superannuation in September 2005 and in the meantime one and half years have been elapsed.

2. It is your further information that for recovery of the aforesaid amount you are required to follow the legal procedures envisaged under the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1965 for initiation of proceeding against Sri Senapati. Chapter-9 of the above Rules provides the procedures for initiation of a disciplinary proceeding against a retired employee. Under Clause-1 of Chapter-9 provides that such proceedings can be initiated within four years of the event took place. Since the breakage in respect of investment under UTI Mutual Fund was from 2003 – 2005 and the agency commission was received within that period, therefore, the limitation of four years is continuing in the year 2007. Under clause-2 of Chapter-9 of the aforesaid rules, the grave misconduct has been defined which is wide enough to include "corrupt practice" and in

case such corruption is proved even after sanction of pension, action to withhold or withdraw pension may be taken. After perusal of records I found that although the financial misconduct committed by Mr. S.S. Senapati was discussed earlier in the meeting of the BOT dated 26.12.2005 and subsequent committee held on 30.03.2007 and recommended for recovery of agent commission and the same was approved by the Director of the Institute but no disciplinary proceeding as provided under the but no disciplinary proceeding as provided under the but no disciplinary proceeding shall be initiated against Sri S.S. Senapati forthwith and after following the due procedure of law and approval of the same by the President, the final order be passed in the name of the President. After communicating the said final order to Mr. S.S. Senapati the recovery can only be made.
