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A) GENERAL AND PROCEDURAL MATTERS.

BOG-81(2022)-01: Welcome to all members along with new BOG member Prof. S. K. Pratihar, Professor, Department of Ceramic Engg, NIT Rourkela nominated from Senate to the meeting by the Chairman.

"As per the Statutes vide Clause No.17(15) – In the event of the occurrence of any vacancy in the office of the Chairperson by reason of his death, resignation or otherwise or in the event of Chairperson being unable to discharge his functions owing to absence, illness or any other cause, till Director may discharge the functions assigned to the Chairperson under 16 of the Act."

The Chairman welcomed all the members including the new member to the meeting.

BOG-81(2022)-02: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 78th meeting of the BOG held on 16.07.2021 through VC.

The minutes of the 78th meeting of the BOG held on 16.07.2021 through VC were sent to all the members for their comments regarding correctness of recording of the minutes. Comments received from the members have been incorporated. The copy of the minutes and comments received from members are given in the Annexure for confirmation by the Board.

The comments received from the BOG members under agenda item No BOG-78(2021)-10:

Views of Five Board Members: -

(i) Padmashree N. R. Mohanty, Ex-Chairman, HAL & Member BOG (mail dated 27 July 2021).

Following facts may be brought to the Board for review and final decision on the subject. Prof. Das was appointed as the Registrar of the institute after due approval of the then BOG for a period of 5 years or up to the age of 62 years whichever is earlier. Accordingly, he joined the institute on 07.05.2019. BOG had earlier, accorded approval taking into account the "Recruitment Rule (2019) for the post of Registrar in NITs. This Rule clearly defines at Para (10) that Deputation (including Short Term Contract) for a period of 5 years or till attaining the age of 62 years whichever is earlier or as fixed by Govt. of India.

"Taking into account the above, my recommendation is the followings:

(a) Prof Das has to retire from his parent/organisation on 28.02.2022 after attaining the age of/60 years.

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- (b) He should continue on contract as Registrar at NIT, Rourkela w. e. f. 01.03.2022 till 28.02.2024 when he completes 62 years of age i.e. before completion of 5 years period which is due on 06.05.2024".
- (ii) <u>Dr. Ajay Kumar Nayak, Joint Secretary, Skill Development and Technical Education, Govt of Odisha</u> & attended the BOG meeting on behalf of Mr Sanjay Kumar Singh, IAS, Commissioner –cum- Secretary to Govt, Skill Development & Technical Education, Dept., Govt of Odisha and Member, BOG (Mail dated 03 August 2021).

"My observation on the matter related to the continuance of Prof. P.K. Das as Registrar, NIT is as follows: Prof. P.K. Das was appointed as Registrar of NIT, Rourkela for a period of 5 years or up to the age of 62 years which is as per the Recruitment Rule -2019, circulated by MHRD / MoE, Gol. The Rule says, the appointment of Registrar for NITs shall be through deputation (short term contract basis) for a period of 5 years or till attaining the age of 62 years, whichever is earlier and his appointment is approved by the BOG of the institute accordingly.

In view of the said facts and the Rule, the BOG may consider as follows:

- (a) Prof Das should get superannuated from his parent organisation VSSUT on 28th February 2022 after attaining the age of 60 years, being relieved from NIT, Rourkela on 27.02.2022.
- (b) He should join back on 01.03.2022 as Registrar of the Institute and continue on contract basis till he attains the age of 62 years, with the stipulated terms & conditions with usual allowance and facilities as per his appointment order".
- (iii) Prof R.V. Raja Kumar, Director, IIT, Bhubaneswar & Member BOG (Mail received on 25th July 2021.

It is mentioned in the minutes as "the BOG is advised". It is not advised, but "it was decided"

(iv) Prof. Nihar Ranjan Mishra, Member, BOG (Mail received on 27th July 2021).

"In the light of Recruitment Rule 2019 for the appointment of Registrars of NITS, circulated by MHRD / MOE (No. F.35 -5 I 2018 – TS. III dated 4th April, 2019) it is clearly mentioned that the mode of appointment of Registrar should be on deputation or

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on a contract basis for a tenure of 5 years or one reaches at the age of 62 years, whichever is earlier. Based on this the appointment letter was issued to the present Registrar, which was approved by the BOG. Hence, this case may be discussed in the next BOG to avoid any legal issues".

(v) Prof. G. K. Panda, Member, BOG (Mail received on 26th July 2021).

"Kindly refer to the attached Recruitment Rules for the Non-Teaching posts in the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) – 2019. On page 3, items 10 and 11, it has been clearly mentioned that the deputation is for a period of 5 years or till attaining the age of 62 years whichever is earlier. In case of deputation, if necessary, one needs to retire from his parent institute, this is natural. The Agenda No. BOG -78 (2021) should be reviewed in the next BOG meeting and a suitable decision should be taken so as to avoid unnecessary legal complications".

(vi) Shri Mrutyunjay Behera, Economic Advisor (HE), MoE, Govt. of India through tele-conference conveyed Prof Animesh Biswas, Director & Chairman acting, BOG NIT, Rourkela, on 18th July and on 25th July 2022.

"That the possibility of converting deputation to contract appointment, till Prof. P. K. Das reaches the age of 62 years can be considered, keeping in view his appointment order and the Recruitment Rule-2019 of Gol for Registrar of NITs and this is to be discussed in next BoG meeting".

Registrar before the discussion on the agenda asked for the permission of the Chairman to be absent during the discussion of this agenda which was pertaining to his case. The Chairman permitted to do so.

Director & Chairman presented the matter to the Board to the Board and the members deliberated on it.

The BOG felt to bring this matter as an agenda item by calling an urgent BOG meeting within a week, looking into its urgency.

"I fully agree with Prof. G. K. Panda. As it is a regular Process, DA and DR should be released as per the Govt. of India notification"

A. POLICY AND IMPORTANT ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS.

BOG-81(2022)-09:

For the perusal of BOG & removal of ambiguity in the matter of selection/ recruitment of Guest faculty on hourly contract basis in accordance with Clause-28 of the first statutes of NITs.

This agenda was circulated among the members of BOG dated 16.12.2021. The members suggested to bring it to the regular BOG meeting for discussion.

With a view to hire Guest faculty in English under HS department, as necessity arose after resignation of concerned faculty teaching English and at the beginning of the spring semester, advertisement was issued [Annexure-A7, Pg.101] Candidates found suitable were interviewed and a final select list has been made by a Standing Selection Committee constituted with approval of BOG vide resolution No.BOG-68(2020)-02, in confirmation with Clause-28 of the first statute of NITs [Annexure-A7, Pg.103].

Query has been made by an internal board member on the inclusion of Registrar as member secretary of this standing selection committee on the ground that Registrar is not made a member for selection of regular faculty.

The resolution/ confirmation of the Board dated 11.02.2020 on the subject was based on Clause -28 of the first statute of NITs to simplify the procedure and avoid frequent reference to the BoG on each occasion.

Clause-28 of the Statute deals with appointment on contract basis and it is a standalone clause on the subject by which the BOG is empowered to constitute such ad-hoc selection committee as the circumstances of each case may require and such constitution of the committee is to be reported to the Board for conformation [Annexure-7, Pg. Pg.102].

Accordingly, the committee has been constituted was referred to BOG for conformation and the same has been confirmed vide BOG-68, dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure / II).

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Since, a point has been raised by one of the internal Board member, it is considered appropriate to refer to the Board for revalidation of its confirmed resolution as mentioned above so as to avoid ambiguity or any question on its propriety.

Board may kindly confirm the constitution of the committee in terms of Clause-28 of the Statutes and the selection of the candidate for Teaching English as Guest Faculty on contractual basis, for one Semester and on hourly basis as per the terms & condition mentioned in advertisement dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure-I).

The Board Deliberating on the above said agenda BOG approve the selection panel and selection procedure as a special case with reference to the Clause-28 of the Statute (as it is hourly basis for limited period (40) classes per semester. However, it suggested in future in any kind of faculty recruitment, the selection committee should follow the norms as per Statutes Clause-23.

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(Post MBBS and Post Diploma). Accordingly, he has requested for Study Leave for 03 years to pursue the same. In this regard, as per Institute Leave Rules, Study Leave will be governed as per provisions of Government of India notified from time to time.

Hence, as per Rule 50 of CCS (Leave) Rules,1972, Medical Officers may be granted study leave for prosecuting a course of postgraduate study in Medical Sciences subject to completion of probation period and he/she must have rendered not less than five years' regular continuous service including the period of probation under the government.

Further, in terms of Rule 51 read with Rule 54(2) of CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972, the maximum amount of study leave may be granted to a Government servant shall be 24 months during the entire service period which can be combined with other kinds of leave, except EOL, involving a total absence of not more than 28 months.

In view of the above, the leave to be sanctioned to Dr. Patnaik may be proposed as below:

- A. First 24 Months: Study Leave
- B. Next 04 Months: Personal Leave, out of which
 - a. First 03 Months : Commuted Leave [as per clause 10(2) of Institute Leave Rule]
 - b. Rest 01 Month : Personal Leave other than Commuted Leave
- C. Balance Period : EOL [as per clause 21 of Institute Leave Rule]
