MINUTES

Senate-87[2019]-01: Welcome to the members and invitees by the Chairman (Senate).

Director and Chairman (Senate) welcomed all members and invitees present in the meeting. Senate granted leave of absence to all the members who could not attend the meeting.

A. RULES, PROCEDURES, CURRICULA AND POLICY MATTERS

Senate-87[2019]-02: Updated Academic Regulations for UG & PG Programmes.

The complete Academic Regulations for the UG Programmes were last approved in 47th meeting of the Senate held on 23.12.2013 (Monday), 03.01.2014 (Friday), 04.01.2014 (Saturday) and 08.01.2014 (Wednesday). There have been additions and modifications thereafter.

Incorporating the additions and modifications as approved in various Senate meetings starting from 48th meeting held on 14th May 2014 till 85th meeting held on 15th July 2019, a draft version of the updated regulation was circulated by email on 5th November 2019. All suggestions received by members were put up on table for deliberation.

After detailed deliberation, Senate finalized the academic regulation for UG programmes and approved it, a copy of which has been enclosed in the Annexure. However, the regulations of PG programmes was deferred due to time constraint.

Senate-87[2019]-03: Regulations for Executive PhD Programme.

First batch of Executive Ph.D. candidates have been admitted in Autumn 2019-20 and departments have been informed to complete their Enrollment, Prov. Registration and First Semester Registration as per guidelines issued vide Circular No.1499, dated 13.09.2019.

Certain activities to be carried out subsequent to completion of above activities were placed in the 86th Senate meeting held on 5th November 2019 for deliberation. Senate advised to prepare a draft of all proposed regulation and put up for further deliberation. A draft Information Brochure containing major regulations required for the admitted candidates was prepared and circulated by email by 11th November 2019. Suggestions received were put up on table.

Senate deferred the item due to time constraint.

Senate-87[2019]-04: Representation from the nominated student member to reconsider the decision taken in 86th Senate meeting regarding policy for conversion of CGPA to percentage.

In 86th meeting of the Senate held on 04 November 2019, It was decided to have policy to convert CGPA awarded by the Institute to percentage by applying following formula "CGPA – 0.5]*10" [e.g. 6.5 CGPA = 60%].

A representation has been received from Soumya Ranjan Mohanty, a nominated student member to reconsider the above decision to have the policy as was proposed in the Agenda of 86th meeting [i.e. CGPA*10 = %age]. Copy of his representation is given in Annexure.

Senate deferred the item due to time constraint.
