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## INSTRUCTION FOR SUBMISSION OF QUOTATION

1. **Tender Fee & Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** A non-refundable Tender Fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five hundred only) and refundable EMD of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) to be deposited through ONLINE mode only using NET-BANKING / NEFT / IMPS to the designated bank account of NIT Rourkela as detailed below:

2. **EMD Exemption:** Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) for goods produced and services rendered, are exempted from paying EMD/Bid Security. Accordingly, MSEs shall be required to submit valid Udyam Registration Certificate for availing benefit under MSE Procurement Policy. The benefit as above to MSMEs shall be available only for Goods produced and services rendered by MSMEs. **However, traders are excluded from the purview of MSME Procurement Policy.**
3. Startup(s) as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Govt. of India, are exempted from paying EMD/Bid Security. However, they have to enclose valid self-attested registration certificate(s) along with the tender to this effect.
4. Eligible MSE and startup bidders who seeks exemption for paying EMD/Bid Security as per above clause, if they withdraw or modify their bids during the period of validity, or if they are awarded the contract and they fail to execute the contract, or to submit a performance security before the deadline defined in the request for bids document/contract, they will be suspended for the period of three years or for a period as decided by the competent authority from being eligible to submit bids for future contracts with the NIT Rourkela. Bidders should submit the duly filled and signed declaration as per the attached format in Annexure – III.
5. **Bidder Turn Over Criteria:** The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the three financial years, ending on 31st March 2025, should be Rs.60,00,000 (Sixty lakhs). Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods OR a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid.
6. **Bidder Experience Criteria:** The bidder must have supplied same or similar category products during last 5 financial years ending on 31 March 2026. Relevant documents in support of the experience criteria must be submitted along with the bid.
7. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.
8. **Data Sheet** of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
9. **Warranty and Support:** Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 5 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the warranty period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance

Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

10. **Rate:** The rate quoted must be inclusive of all the taxes & incidental charges. The bidders should quote their rates in clear terms without ambiguity in Price Bid (BOQ). In case of discrepancy between the rates in figures and words, the rate in words shall prevail.

11. **Documents to be submitted:**

**(i) Cover – I: Technical Part** (all documents must be self-attested)

- a) Copy of Valid Legal Status (Proprietorship / Partnership / Public Limited / Private Limited)
- b) Copy of Valid PAN Card
- c) Copy of Valid GST Registration Certificate

**(ii) Cover – II: Price Bid** (Duly filled and signed Price Bid)

**NOTE: Bids not accompanied by any of the above documents shall be rejected summarily.**

12. Late bids, that is, bids received after the specified date and time of receipt shall not be considered.
13. **Period of Validity:** A quotation shall remain valid for acceptance at least for a period of 30 days from the date of opening.
14. **Rejection of Bid / Offer:** The Institute reserves the right to reject any or all bid / offer without assigning any reason thereof.
15. The bid document / resultant contract shall be interpreted under Indian Laws.
16. The lowest quoted value amongst responsive bidders shall be accepted, and an acceptance / purchase order shall be issued. However, in exceptional circumstances, where the price offered by Lowest (L1) bidder is not reasonable, a negotiation shall be held only with that bidder.
17. The Acceptance Letter / Purchase Order would be issued to the successful bidder(s) notifying the quantity and schedule of delivery.
18. In case the successful bidder does deliver the mentioned Goods or in delays supply of goods, the EMD shall be forfeited, and other actions initiated, including resale of the goods in question at the risk and cost of the defaulter.
19. In case the lowest acceptable bidder cannot accept supply the mentioned goods, the remaining quantity shall be offered to the next lowest bidder(s) at the price offered by the lowest acceptable bidder.
20. If the bidder's offer is not accepted, the bidder's EMD shall be refunded to the firm. No interest shall be payable on such refunds. The EMD deposited by the successful bidder shall remain with the NIT Rourkela supply of all the goods. Upon successfully lifting of all items, EMD shall be refunded within 15 days.
21. **Delivery Period:** The goods are required to be delivered at designated department / office of NIT Rourkela within 60 days from the date of placement of Purchase Order under the risk and

arrangement of the bidder and offers with delivery beyond the above period shall be treated as unresponsive. In case the delivery time is higher, the same must be mentioned clearly in the quotation.

22. **Award of Contract:** Contract shall be awarded to lowest quoted (L1) bidder along with submission of all the technical documents as mentioned. **Lowest (L1) bidder shall be determined on overall quoted price in Price Bid (BOQ).**
23. **Performance Security / Security Deposit:** The successful bidder upon receipt of the Award of Contract shall have to deposit a Performance Security (PS) of 3% of total contract value, within 15 days after issuance of Award of Contract. Performance Security may be furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee (including e-bank guarantee) issued / confirmed from any of the scheduled banks in India, ONLINE mode using NET-BANKING or payment online in an acceptable form. Performance Security shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations.
24. If the bidder, fails to furnish the Performance Security within the specified period, NIT Rourkela at its discretion to annul the award and enforce Bid Security Declaration (in lieu of forfeiture of the Bid Security / EMD), in addition to other administrative punitive action as deemed appropriate.
25. **Payment Terms:** Unless otherwise stipulated in the Purchase Order, 100% payment shall be made against successful delivery and acceptance of the goods by NITR as confirmed by the consignee, endorsed by the indenter and approved by the indentors' Head of Department / Section.
26. Tax invoices (in triplicate) shall be in original and shall contain the NITR Purchase Order number, and a description, the quantities, unit and total price(s) of the Goods delivered. The currency of the invoice and payment shall be as specified in the Purchase Order.
27. The NITR shall not pay any charge for late payments. No advance payment of any type (Mobilization, secured advances etc.), shall be made by the Institute to the contractor.
28. **Liquidated Damages:** The liquidated damages shall be levied, for delay in supply beyond the contractual delivery date at the rate of 1% per unit per week of delay or part thereof on delayed supply of goods and / or services until actual delivery or performance subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract price of the equipment the delivery of which is delayed, for each month or part of a month.

## **Annexure – I: Technical Specification of the Active Network Components**

### **A. Technical Specification for 24-Port non-POE Managed Ethernet Switches (Qty: 4)**

1. Should be rack mountable.
2. Should have minimum one internal PSU and one internal fan.
3. Should support minimum 24 x 1 Gbps copper ports.
4. Should support minimum 4 x 10G SFP+ ports for uplink.
5. Should have built-in USB port to facilitate upload/download of configuration files and Firmware updates.
6. Should support a dual firmware image architecture.
7. Should have non-blocking architecture with minimum 128 Gbps switching fabric/bandwidth and minimum 95.2 Mpps packet forwarding rate.
8. Should support minimum 256 VLANS.
9. Should support minimum 16K MAC address database size.
10. Should support minimum 512 multicast groups.
11. Should support advanced features such as IPv4/IPv6 Layer 3 static routing.
12. Should support L2 Services such as Broadcast, Multicast and unknown Unicast storm control, STP (Rapid STP & Multiple STP) and DHCP Relay.
13. Should support L3 Services such as DHCP snooping, Static routing and VLAN routing.
14. Should support 802.1x RADIUS Network Access Control, L2/L3 ACLs, DoS attacks prevention, Network storm protection, Port Security and Dynamic ARP inspection.
15. Should support Voice VLAN with SIP and LLDP-MED IP phones automatic QoS and VLAN configuration.
16. Operating Temperature should be from 0° to 50°C (32° to 122°F).

### **B. Technical Specification for Multi User - MIMO Gigabit WiFi-6 Access Point (Qty: 50)**

1. Should be an Enterprise-grade Wi-Fi 6 (802.11ax) Access Point or higher.
2. Should have backward compatibility to 802.11 a/b/g/n/ac.
3. Should have minimum 3/4dBi (2.4GHz/5GHz) or better internal Antenna Gain.
4. Should have minimum one 100/1000/2.5GBASE-T Gigabit Ethernet port to support 802.3af or 802.3at Power over Ethernet (PoE).
5. Should have provision for 12V DC power connector on the Access Point.
6. Should have aggregate throughput 3.6Gbps (5.0GHz: 2.4Gbps and 2.4GHz: 1.2Gbps) or better.
7. Should support Bidirectional (Bidir) and Multi User MIMO (MIMO).
8. Should support IEEE 802.11ax Wi-Fi 6 standard
9. Should support Wireless Bridge mode (WDS or equivalent) enabling point-to-point and multi-point connectivity.
10. Should support MAC address filtering with access control mechanisms to restrict network access only to authorized devices.
11. Should support Guest Network and Captive Portal to keep the guest users isolated from the internal LAN resources.
12. Should support 4 x 4 (Transmit x Receive) Wireless Mode in both 5.0GHz and 2.4GHz frequency bands.
13. Wireless LAN solution must support blocking or disabling SSID broadcast for enhanced wireless security.
14. Should support Wi-Fi security standards such as WPA/WPA2/WPA3 and 802.11i to protect wireless networks through authentication and encryption.
15. Should have operating temperature minimum 0° to 40°C (32° to 104°F).
16. Access point should be supplied with Ceiling/Wall mounting kit.
