About the CoE on Public Health Nutrition, Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, NIT, Rourkela

The Department of Humanities and Social Sciences has started a Centre of Excellence (CoE) on Public Health Nutrition (PHN) with the initial support of UNICEF. The basic objective of the CoE is to strengthen collaboration on knowledge management regarding food and nutrition security and public health nutrition. The Center intends to create, update, share and use the knowledge on public health nutrition and make it more accessible to both internal and external stakeholders. The CoE shall be conducting various assessments, studies, develop policy notes, process documentation, situational analysis, facilitate crucial workshops/training, conduct academic collaborations and knowledge management activities in the field of public health nutrition.

Objective of the workshop

Better health and nutrition is central to human wellbeing and contributes towards economic progress and enhanced savings of a country. The health system of a region can be made more effective, efficient and equitable with the application of health economics principles. Health and nutrition economics is a study resources are allocated among different of how scarce alternatives for various health promotions, protections and preventive measures, thereby ensuring judicious use of available resources for maximizing health benefits. Nutrition economics is a discipline dedicated to researching and characterizing health and economic outcomes in nutrition for the benefit of the society. It studies the interdependency between the nutritional behavior, health and public expenses. The subject also includes quality, value and behaviour in the delivery and consumption of nutrition and healthcare products and services and includes spending by both public and private sources.

The objective of the five-day course is to support the health and nutrition professionals to understand the basic concepts of health economics and enable them to take better decisions in the health/nutrition sector. The training will focus on the theoretical aspects and application of Health Economics concepts. By the end of the training, the participants should be able to plan and also assess/evaluate various health care and nutrition programmes/policies in terms of costs incurred and the benefits/outcomes achieved.

Who should attend the Applied Health & Nutrition Economics workshop?

The Applied Health& Nutrition Economics workshop would be suitable for the working health care/nutrition professionals, budget officers/ finance officers working in Health, W & CD, Planning and Convergence Departments at National or State level, faculty members & trainers, senior project managers and NGO officials/promoters working in the public health nutrition sector. Further, professionals engaged in health and nutrition related planning, proposal development and economic evaluation of health programmes in reputed national/international NGOs, UN bodies and government organizations would find the workshop extremely useful. A few research scholars and Post-Doctoral fellows from reputed academic institutions will be given a chance to attend the training. Professionals with experience in development consultancy firms and those interested economic evaluations (cost benefit/cost effectiveness/cost utility analysis) are also encouraged to apply.

Resource Persons

The resource persons will be a mix of industry experts and eminent academicians from NIT Rourkela and other institutes of repute.

Delivery Methodology

The workshop utilizes hands-on-skill development approaches through the use of case studies, group exercises, presentations and other participatory adult learning methods.

Certificate: A certificate will be given to the participants after successful completion of the course conducted by the CoE PHN, NIT, Rourkela.
